Sir,

In continuation of this Deptt.'s G. O. No. 59(Sanction)/P/SC dt.15.6.10 & 89(Sanction)/P/SC dt.4.10.10., I am directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to sanction an expenditure of Rs.27,10,11,970/- (Rupees twenty seven crore ten lakh eleven thousand nine hundred and seventy) only to meet the expenditure for "Old Age Pension to B.P.L. Scheduled Tribes living in rural areas" for the period from January, 2011 to March, 2011 in the current financial year 2010-11 @ Rs.750/- p.m. per head. Pension shall be disbursed through S/B Account of Pensioners. Exception is allowed in extreme cases at the discretion of DMs..


The Governor is also pleased to allot the said amount of Rs.27,10,11,970/- (Rupees twenty seven crore ten lakh eleven thousand nine hundred and seventy) only to the concerned district authorities noted in Annexure 'A' for meeting the expenditure in their respective districts for the period from January, 2011 to March, 2011 in the current financial year 2010-11. The district-wise break-up of the allotment has been shown in the Annexure 'A'. The concerned district authorities i.e., all P.O.-cum-D.W.O., B.C.W./D.W.O., BCW/ Principal Secretary D.G.H.C. is hereby authorized to act as Drawing and Disbursing Officer in respect of the said fund as detailed in Annexure 'A'.

Utilization Certificate for the present sanction together with the utilization certificates for the previous sanction of 2010-2011 should be sent to this Department within the stipulated period.

The charge on this account will be debited to the head, "2225-Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes-02-Welfare of Scheduled Tribes-796 Tribal Areas Sub-Plan-SP-State Plan (Annual Plan 11<sup>th</sup> Plan)-051-Old Age Pension to persons belonging to Scheduled Tribes-V-31-Grant-in-aid-02-Other Grants" under Demand No.07 Department Code: 'SC' [Code: 07-SC-2225-02-796-SP-051-V-31-02], in the budget of the current financial year 2010-11.
