No. 4045-BCW/MR-109/13.- the 28th November, 2017 — WHEREAS after careful consideration of all aspects, it is considered necessary by the State Government to amend the income criteria, as mentioned in serial No. VI of Schedule II to the West Bengal Backward Classes (Other than Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) (Reservation of Vacancies in Services and Posts) Act, 2012 (West Ben. Act XXXIX of 2012) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act);

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by section 16 of the said Act and in supersession of all earlier orders issued on the subject, the Governor is pleased hereby to make, with immediate effect, the following amendment in the Schedule II appended to the said Act:—

*Amendment*

In serial No. VI and the entries relating thereto of the Schedule II to the said Act, *substitute* the following serial No. and the entries relating thereto:—

“VI.	INCOME/WEALTH TAX	<p>Son(s) and daughter(s) of—</p> <p>(a) persons having gross annual income of Rs. 8 lakh or above or possessing wealth above the exemption limit as prescribed in the Wealth Tax Act for a period of three years;</p> <p>(b) persons in categories I, II, III and VA who are not disentitled to the benefit of reservation but have income from other sources of wealth which will bring them within the income/wealth criteria mentioned in (a) above.</p> <p><i>Explanation.</i>— Income from salaries and agricultural land shall not be clubbed.”.</p>
